Dear Parents,

Marcellin College has qualified 10 out of 12 teams to compete in the MCC Basketball, Cricket, Tennis and Touch Football Grand Finals this Thursday 22nd February. We will contest the A Grade, B Grade, U15 & U14 Basketball; A Grade, U16 & U14 Cricket; B Grade & U14 Touch Football; and the Tennis Grand Final. I'd like to congratulate all the boys and their coaches on a successful season so far and wish our teams the best of luck this Thursday.

As is our usual practice, a number of year groups will attend the Grand Final games as supporters. Our arrangements are as follows:

Year 7	Normal periods 1, 2, 3 & lunch. Boys will assemble at the end of lunch and be transported to Coral Sea Park for normal sport activities.
Year 8	Boys are to attend Homeroom and then be transported to Holy Cross College Ryde to support the U14 Touch Football team with the game commencing at 10am. The group will then be transported to Yarra Bay where they will have lunch and participate in their regular sport activities.
Year 9	Boys are to attend Homeroom and then be transported to Alexandria Basketball Stadium to support the U14 and U15 Basketball teams with the games to be played at 10am and 11am. The group will then be transported to Heffron Park where they will have lunch and participate in their regular sport activities.
Year 10	Normal periods 1, 2, & recess. Boys will be transported to Holy Cross College Ryde where they will support the B Grade Touch Football team in their Grand Final commencing at 12pm. Boys will be transported back to school and be dismissed at approximately 2pm.
Year 11	Normal Homeroom, periods 1, 2 & recess. Boys will then be transported to Alexandria Basketball Stadium to support the B Grade Basketball team with the game commencing at 12pm. At the conclusion of the match the boys will be transported back to school and be dismissed at approximately 2pm.
Year 12	Normal Homeroom, periods 1, 2, recess and period 3. Boys will then be transported to Alexandria Basketball Stadium to support the A Grade Basketball team with the game commencing at 1pm. At the conclusion of the game, boys will be transported back to school and dismissed at approximately 2:30pm.

We expect full cooperation from all boys and remind them of College expectations when in the public arena. College sports uniform must be worn and boys are to bring their own lunch, snacks and drinks.

Arrangements for our Summer Representative teams are as follows:

Basketball	The U14 & U15 Basketball teams will depart school at 8:30am on the College mini bus. The A & B Grade teams will attend P1 & P2 and will depart school at 10:40am on the College mini bus. A bus will return players to school at the conclusion of the A Grade match. They are expected to arrive back at the College at 2:30pm. Players are permitted to leave from the venue with parents.
Cricket	All teams will attend Homeroom then be transported to Kensington Oval (A Grade) and Rowland Park (U14/U16) with matches beginning at 10am. Boys are dismissed from the venue.
Touch	The U14 (10am start) and B Grade Touch (12pm start) teams will depart the College at 8:30am for Holy Cross College Ryde. Boys will be transported back to the College at the conclusion of the B Grade match and be dismissed at approximately 2:00pm.
Tennis	The Tennis squad will attend Homeroom and P1 and will depart school at 9:30am for Illawarra Tennis Centre. Boys will be transported back to the College and will be dismissed at approximately 1:30pm.
