Dear Parents,

Each year, Year 7 and 11 students attend the Metropolitan Catholic Colleges Swimming Carnival at the Sydney Aquatic Centre, Homebush in support of our representative swimmers. This year the Carnival will be held on **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> March at 4:30pm**. Marcellin has a fine tradition of success and support at this Carnival. The MCC Swimming Carnival is an event of colour and excitement. **This is a compulsory event for Year 7**. The senior students lead our Year 7 boys through war cries and chants in support of the team. This is a wonderful experience for the newest members of our community and a good opportunity to demonstrate the spirit within our College.

The arrangements for this day are as follows:

- Year 7 boys complete their usual Thursday timetable.
- After lunch Year 7 will gather in the Vaughan Centre and watch a film.
- The school will provide a BBQ and a drink following the film.
- Buses will then transport Year 7 to Sydney Aquatic Centre, Homebush at 3pm.
- Competition begins at 4:30pm and concludes at approximately 7.00pm (with trophy presentations to follow).
- Buses will return to the College at approximately 8.15 - 8.30pm. Students will be dropped off in the school grounds and can be picked up from the front gate on Alison Road.
- Full College sports uniform must be worn.

Boys must bring food and drinks for the afternoon/evening as the canteen will not be in use for our students. Students are not to bring valuable items to the Carnival.

All class teachers are aware of this obligation for Year 7 and therefore will limit homework for this evening.

Yr 11 students attending the carnival will remain at school for sport, and leave for the carnival on buses at 2.45pm. A medical certificate will be required to verify any absence, as is the normal practice. Any student who normally works on a Thursday afternoon/evening will need to notify their employer of their absence on this day.
