## Dates for End of Term 2013 and Start of Year 2014

### 2013

- Friday, 6 December:** Year 11 final day of classes
- Monday, 9 December:** Year 10 final day of term: Liturgy & Prizegiving 9.30am
- 9 - 13 (Mon - Fri) December:** (Week 10) Classes as usual for boys in Years 7, 8 & 9
- Monday, 16 December:** Years 7, 8 & 9 Picnic Day

Years 7, 8 & 9 have a Picnic Day organised for Monday, 16 December. Parents should have received separate correspondence about this. In the case of inclement weather, parents are to check the College website on Monday morning. If the weather is unsuitable for this planned activity then the day will be cancelled, and students are granted a school free day. If the weather is suitable the day will proceed – attendance is compulsory and usual procedures and penalties will apply for anyone absent. **This is the last day of school for 2013 for boys in Yrs 7, 8 & 9.**

**Wednesday, 18 December:** Years 7-10 Parent Feedback Meetings with Subject Teachers

This day provides a valuable opportunity for dialogue between parents and teachers. Boys should also attend this interview with their parents (school uniform is not required). - 1.00pm - 3.30pm: Interviews by appointment only
- 3.30pm - 5.00pm: 'Drop in' meeting time, no appointment necessary
- 5.00pm - 6.00pm: Interviews by appointment only

Appointments should be made by emailing teachers directly and will be of 10 minutes duration each. For this day to run successfully it is important that no interview runs beyond the 10 minutes allocated.
